About Camp Chaverim

CHAVERIM -(Primer/Kindergarten- Grade 4)

Your child will have the “Summer of a lifetime”. Separate boys and girls division allow for gender appropriate activities. Both divisions will have swim and daily learning sessions with professional experienced Rabbiem. Highlights include:

- Weekly davening raffles
- Daily benching contests
- Exciting weekly theme focused on during morning lineup
- Erev Shabbos Oneg & Tisch
- Exciting trips
- Kashrut supervised by Mashgiach
- Separate Male/Female divisions, including separate swims
- Chinuch program - age appropriate initiative.

TZFAT - (Grades 5 & 6) The philosophy of Camp Chaverim, with a higher anticipation of Jewish learning. Boys will have a strong focus on Sports leagues and tournaments. Girls will focus on a higher level of dance and drama. There will be up to 10 exciting trips dispersed throughout the summer.

TIYULIM (Grades 7,8 & 9) Specific for our older and more mature campers. This pre-requisite to the CIT Program allows for boys and girls divisions to choose from a variety of activities while on campus. On Fridays, one half of the day is spent on a Chesed project and the other half in “training” to become future counselors. The week culminates in an Erev Shabbos Oneg & Tisch. Up to three trips a week with selected other Chaverim groups include sports events, museums, amusement parks, historical sites and places of interest.

*Boys and girls may travel together on trip days.

Additional Information

Catered lunch by an approved Kosher provider is included in your tuition. A wide and creative menu will give a daily view of the foods served. On trip days (as assigned on your camp calendar), campers must bring a brown bag lunch . The Nosh, our snack bar is open daily 8:30 - 4:30 to make purchases.

Transportation – to and from camp is available from select areas where there is one or more campers. Along with camp trips, our contracted bus service, Belair Transport, provides the highest standards of safety and efficiency.

Camp Health – In compliance with NJ State camp licensing, a health professional is on staff during regular camp hours. We will need an updated signed medical form for each camper. Without this your child(ren) may not be allowed to participate in activities or leave the building. It is essential that you list all allergies, medications and special needs.

Early Drop-Off (7:30 am) **Late Pick-UP** (6:00 pm) are available. Additional activities, games, movies & snacks will be supervised.
